JOURNEY° II XR Instructional Course	<p>Course Objectives: Surgeon participants will learn about the history and current design rationale of bi-cruciate retaining knees, including indications and surgical technique, through didactic presentations and hands on skills training in cadaveric labs. XR will be shown with standard instrumentation and with the enabling technologies, NAVIO° and VISIONAIRE° Adaptive Guides.</p> <p>Target Attendee Profile: Attendees should be current users of JOURNEY° II TKA or past users of bi-cruciate retaining knee designs.</p>
NAVIO° Users Group Meeting	<p>Course Objectives: Surgeon participants will gain exposure to the various knee applications that NAVIO° offers and learn how to expand indications around NAVIO uni, TKA and XR.</p> <p>Target Attendee Profile: Attendees should be current users of NAVIO° robotics who are interested in learning how to expand to new procedures and advanced indications.</p>
